Purpose

Consent

2. The collection, use and retention of the data listed in this Privacy Policy.

Personal Data We Collect

We only collect data that helps us achieve the purpose set out in this Privacy Policy. We will not collect any additional data beyond the data listed below without notifying you first.

If data is collected automatically, it is obscure and does not contain any personal information and is used purely for statistical measures.

Data Collected in a Non-Automatic Way

We may also collect data when you perform certain functions on our Site:

1. Email address and name

This data is collected using the following method:

1. Subscribing to our Newsletter

How We Use Personal Data

Data collected on our Site will only be used for the purposes specified in this Privacy Policy or indicated on the relevant pages of our Site. We will not use your data beyond what we disclose in this Privacy Policy.

The data we collect automatically is used for the following purpose:

1. Statistics

The data we collect when the user performs certain functions may be used for the following purpose:

1. Communication: to respond to messages received via the Site.

Who We Share Personal Data With **Executive Committee**

We may disclose user data to a member of our Executive Committee of My Place Gold Coast who reasonably needs access to user data to achieve the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. For example, adding the email address and name to the Newsletter database.

Other Disclosures

We will not sell or share your data with other third parties, except in the following cases:

1. If the law requires it;
2. If it is required for any legal proceeding; and
3. To prove or protect our legal rights.

If you follow the hyperlinks from our Site to another Site, please note that we are not responsible for and have no control over their privacy policies and practices.

How Long We Store Personal Data

We ensure strong security measures on our website to prevent illegal access. Only two people have access to data and passwords, which are changed periodically and immediately when one admin person with access leaves the position.

While we take all responsible precautions to ensure that user data is secure and that users are protected, there always remains the risk of harm. The Internet as a whole can be insecure at times and therefore, we are unable to guarantee the security of user data beyond what is reasonably practical.

Children

We do not knowingly collect or use personal data from children under the age of 16. If we learn we have collected personal data from a child under 16, the personal data will be deleted as soon as possible. If a child under 16 years of age has provided us with personal data, their parent or guardian may contact us via email.
